



Studying **SACE** at school

Students from Year 10 onwards are working towards achieving the **South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE)** - a qualification that requires the completion of 200 credits of study. Each semester subject is worth 10 credits towards the certificate.

At Stage 1 level these subjects must be completed with a C or higher:

- Exploring Identities & Futures (EIF)
- 1 semester of Maths
- 2 semesters of English

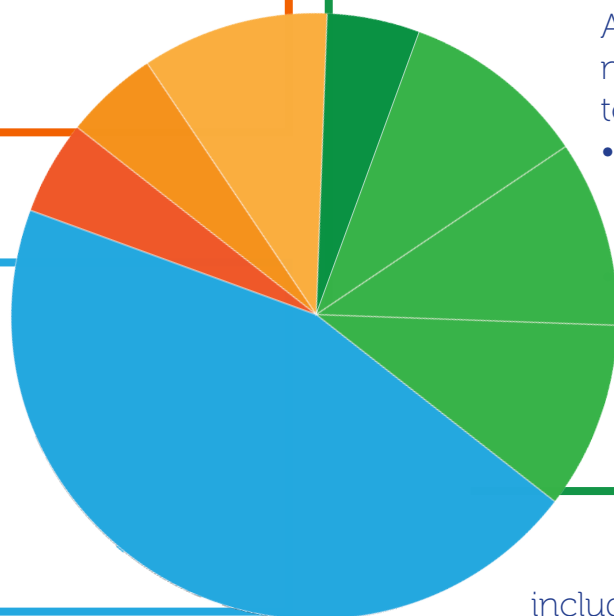
At Stage 2 level these subjects must be completed with a C or higher:

- Activating Identities & Futures (AIF)
- 3 full year Stage 2 subjects or VET equivalent

An additional Stage 2 subject is needed for an ATAR. You need to research:

- Precluded combinations and counting restrictions for SACE subjects.
- Pre-requisite subjects needed to apply for the Uni course you want to study and assumed knowledge.

The remaining 90 credits can be made up of Stage 1 or Stage 2 credits including VET equivalent or other recognised learning.

Students Online accessing results

You can access your SACE:

- Enrolments

- anytime via **Students Online**.

Go to sace.sa.edu.au to access your SACE info:

- Click on the button at the top right of the page that says **"Students Online"**.
- Type in your SACE number (*6 digits plus a letter*).
- Type in your password (*first 4 numbers of your date of birth*).

Click on the tabs marked *Results*, *SACE Planner* and *SACE Progress Checker*.

Did you know?

The **SACE Planner** in Students Online not only shows you your current SACE pattern. You can also explore subject options adding subjects to the planner to trial the impact on your SACE.

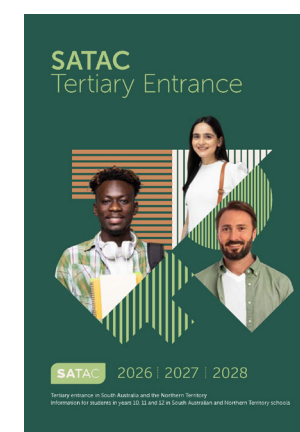
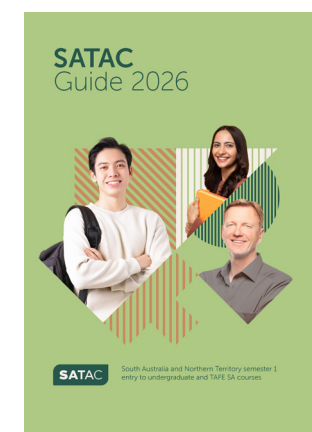
You can apply through SATAC to study at:

There are various entry options for University. Check out the option that suits you for the Universities that you are most interested in:

- ATAR using SACE completion that includes 4 full year SACE Stage 2 subjects + AIF or 3 full year SACE Stage 2 + AIF + VET equivalent.
- Certificate 3 and up
- Sit the STAT test
- Foundation Studies at Flinders or UniStart at Adelaide Uni
- Flinders UniTest + the ATAR

You can apply to study:

- Short courses
- Certificate courses

Possible entry options include:

- Sitting the Core Skills Profile for Adults
- Other completed certificate courses
- SACE completion = TAFE Selection Score
