

Food Futures 2027



The Seaton High School Food Futures program is an Entrepreneurial SACE Package. In this program, students are exposed to contemporary food movements and trends to gain a deeper understanding of the need for sustainability and ethical perspectives at a local and global level. Working with food, students collaborate with community mentors to contribute to their community in a meaningful way.

This program is open to Year 10 students in 2027. By engaging in this program, students will gain industry standard knowledge and be exposed to a range of meaningful pathways and networks within the food and hospitality industry. Students will complete Semester 1 Australian Curriculum and Semester 2 Stage 1 Integrated Learning (10 credits).

In this program students will have access to industry relevant mentors to support and develop key skills in venture planning and implementation. This will empower students to identify and pursue their own entrepreneurial opportunities.
